What is Academic Integrity?

Academic integrity means submitting your own work, giving credit where it’s due, and following the rules set by your instructors. Violations include:

- **Plagiarism** – don’t cherry-pick someone else’s work without citing it
- **Cheating** – don’t try to sneak a grape into your exam basket
- **Fabrication** – don’t make up data like a fruit salad with imaginary ingredients
- **Unauthorized collaboration** – don’t mix your smoothie with others’ assignments unless allowed

Student Responsibilities

1. **Submit Original Work**
Keep your assignments ripe and authentic—no copying from the compost pile!
2. **Cite Sources Properly**
Give credit like seeds in a fruit salad; every source counts.
3. **Follow Assessment Rules**
Stick to your course instructions—no sneaky peels or hidden pits.
4. **Report Misconduct**
If you spot a rotten apple, let the course coordinator know.
